**Garfield Weston Award**

- be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- have completed or be presently completing secondary school diploma/credentials OR have been out of school (post-secondary studies) for a minimum of three years (students who are presently enrolled in colleges doing their high school equivalency are eligible to apply);
- be entering his or her first-year of full-time college studies in the fall of 2010 leading to a diploma or applied degree (university transfer programs, post-graduate, and pre-university DEC studies are **not eligible**) in a program recognized as eligible by the college and the Garfield Weston Awards;
- be entering full-time college studies of at least 16 months in duration with a 100% full-time course load; and
- have a minimum average of 75% in courses required for his or her college program of choice
